



At Rosley CE Primary School, we use 'Teach Computing' and 'Switched On' schemes to assist teacher planning. Below is an overview of the learning focus for each half term in each class. Pupils receive 1 hour per week of timetabled computing lessons. They are taught in sequenced weekly lessons covering the content of the National Curriculum. We use Project Evolve to deliver Online safety lessons across the school.

Class teachers may choose to adapt the learning focus to suit their class but must ensure full coverage throughout the two-yearly cycle.
