<u>English</u>

We will continue to develop our phonics skills and reading fluency and comprehension through the Read, Write, Inc programme.

The children will study a range of books during these lessons. They will have the opportunity

to:

- Learn new phonemes and graphemes in phonics
- Make inferences and predictions about the books
 - In English we will use Talk4Writing to develop our skills as writers. We will focus on developing our descriptive writing as we focus on describing story settings.

In Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling we are:

- Learning to use of capital letters and full stops at the start and end of a sentence
- Exploring a range of adjectives
- Using question marks in the correct place
- Practising proofreading and editing work

<u>Science</u>

Seasonal Change & Plants

In Science, we will be investigating why we have seasons and what distinguishes the different seasons. We will then turn our focus to Plants, considering what plants need to grow and observing growth over time. We will categorise different plant types and identify the key parts of plants.

Maths

The children will also be completing the NCETM Mastering number programme to promote mathematical fluency.



<u> PE</u>

In Dance, we will be performing short motifs and then linking these together to produce dance sequences.

We will further develop our gymnastics skills by focusing on floor work. We will explore fun ways to move our bodies and to use them to make different shapes.

<u>History</u>

This term we will be learning about local history. We will explore the history of Rosley, focusing on the buildings that mean most to us: the school, village hall and the church. We will consider what life was like for children in the past.



<u>RE</u>

We will be learning more about the life of Jesus as we consider the reasons why Easter matters to Christians and why some Christians put a cross in an Easter garden.



<u>Music</u>

The children will explore how music can be used to tell a story and how voices and instruments can be used to represent different characters. They will continue to use graphic scores to read and compose music.



<u>Art</u>

Our focus this half term is sculpture. The children will use natural loose parts as well as clay to create 3d art.



Computing

This half term we will focus on moving robots. We will look at algorithms and programs. We will learn to move the beebots along a pre-planned route and then create our own routes.
